6. York residence requirement: a minimum of 30 credits including at least 50% of the major must be completed at York.
7. Cumulative GPA: to proceed in good standing, a minimum Cumulative GPA of 4.0 is needed.
8. Credits for graduation: at least 90 successfully completed.
9. To graduate: a minimum Cumulative GPA of 4.0 is needed.
